About the Program

The social committee in place at Saskatoon Co-op consists of employees interested in organizing staff functions. This committee is responsible for planning and organizing staff functions. These functions must be a social, cultural, or recreational in nature. Some examples of events organized in the past are:

In 2015, this grant was \$11,170 (\$10 per employee). This money is used to help finance any activities put on by the social club.
